Product Description: Precipitated hydrated silica refers to the product obtained by reacting sodium silicate solution with acid (usually sulfuric acid), followed by precipitation, filtration, drying, crushing or granulation. Its composition can be expressed as SiO2·nH2O. Due to its chemical inertness, stability to chemical agents and ability to significantly improve the mechanical properties of rubber products (such as tensile strength, wear resistance, anti-aging, tear resistance, etc.), it is widely used as a chemical filler in tires, footwear, silicone rubber, feed, coatings, oral care, daily necessities, medicine and other fields.

System Boundary:

The Life cycle stages of from cradle to grave included material acquisition and manufacturing processes.

Data Collection:

Data collected for this PCF calculation and reporting was from 01/01/2024 to 31/12/2024.
